Mr. Bruce David Craymer, age 55, passed away April 10, 2012 from his strong fight of a second bout of industrial cancer. He was born in Muskegon, December 2, 1956 to Caesar and Florence (Glance) Craymer. Bruce was a chemical worker for Lomac Inc. for 26 years and Lift Tech for 5 years. On October 30, 1976 he married Pamela Stevens and they enjoyed 35 years together. Bruce loved to ride his Harley Davidson, fishing, and watching the Detroit Tigers. He was a very caring and giving husband, father and friend. 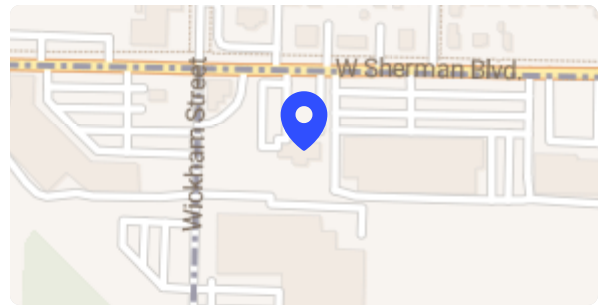
