## Mr. George Jacob Rosema

OCT 19, 1920 - JUN 12, 2018

He served his country in the U.S. Army during WWII. On April 15, 1951, he married the former Flossie Genevieve Gonyon and she preceded him in death on December 14, 2010. George worked for the Norge Corporation for 10 years and then with Teledyne Continental as a machinist for 40 years, retiring in 1987. He enjoyed working on cars and trucks; putting them back together and reading about them. 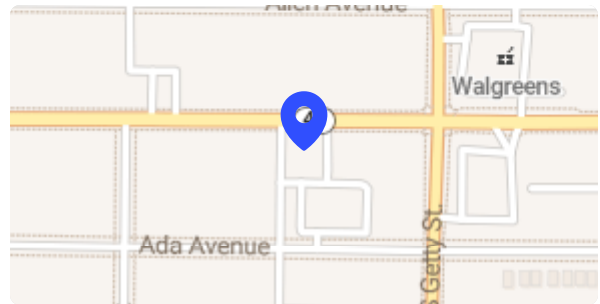

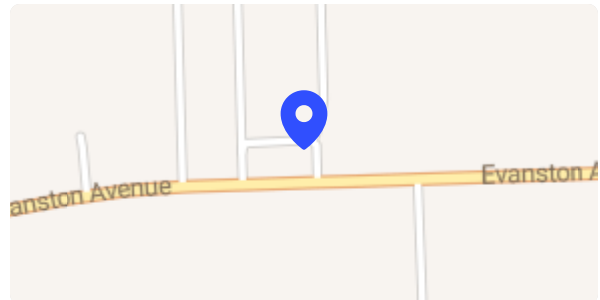
