Mr. Harrison Frank "Harry" Lowden, age 80, went to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ Wednesday, June 20, 2012. Mr. Lowden was born October 5, 1931 to Frank W. and Mary Elizabeth (Krum) Lowden in Grand Rapids, MI. He served his country in the US Army during the Korean War. On November 27, 1952 he married the former Velma D. Billington and she survives him. Harry was employed as head custodian with Orchard View Public Schools for 20 years, retiring in 1988; prior to that he had worked at S.D. Warren Paper Company. Harry was a member of Church of God United where he had been a former treasurer, had served on the board and had been the custodian. He was also a member of Disabled American Veterans Wood-Tazelaar Post, Chapter 11. His family, especially his grandchildren, was the joy of his life.
