**M**r. Harley Blaire Husid, age 61, passed away Saturday, May 25, 2019 after a short recurring battle with cancer. Harley was born on February 16, 1958 to Harry and Helen (Luria) Husid in Newark, NJ. He attended Oakland Community College and Grand Valley State University where he obtained degrees in Hospitality Management. Harley had a long standing passion for photography. He also loved nature, hiking, and the great outdoors. He combined his two favorite hobbies by honing his skills as an amateur photographer, that kept many in awe of his artistic output of the landscapes and views of West Michigan. 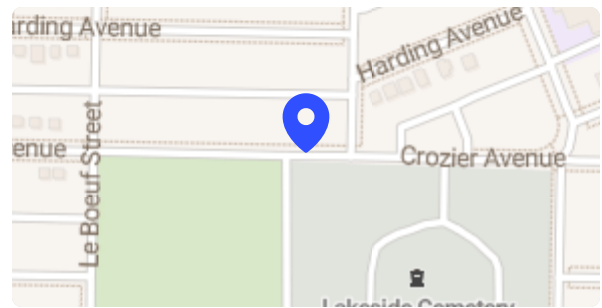

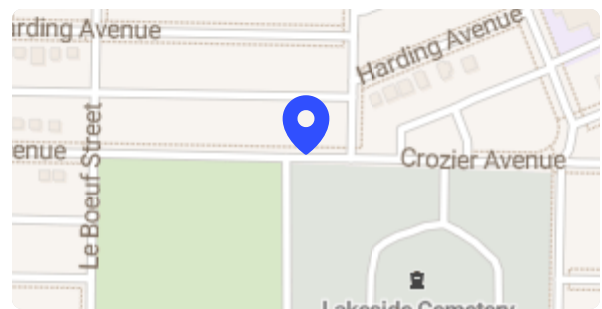
