Mr. Sherman L. Moore, age 78, passed away Thursday evening, July 12, 2012 at Great Lakes Specialty Hospital. He was born October 8, 1933 in Ravenna, MI to Walter and Jacquette (Good) Moore and has resided in the Muskegon area since 1945. He retired in 1994 as a Supervisor from Loren Industries, where he had been employed 38 years. Mr. Moore was a member of St. Mark Lutheran Church, the Model "A" Club and of the Fruitport Eagles. 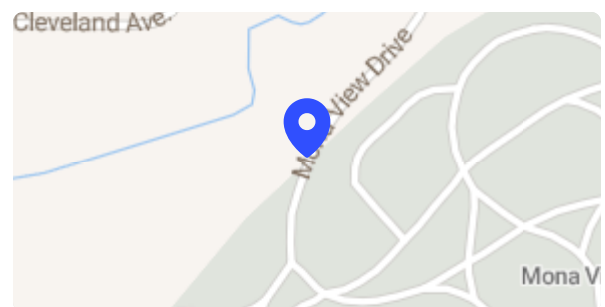
