Kay F. (Ayotte) Ferenz, age 77, passed away on Sunday, January 19, 2020 at the Poppen Residence of Harbor Hospice following complications of a surgery in October. Kay was born December 4, 1942 in Ishpeming, MI to Edward and Mary (LaCombe) Ayotte and lived most of her life in the Muskegon area. She was a graduate of Muskegon Catholic Central High School Class of 1961. Kay married Robert E. “Bob” Ferenz on May 8, 1965 in Muskegon and he preceded her in death on November 11, 2017.
