Raymond L. Cvengros, age 82, passed away at home Wednesday, March 18, 2020 in Muskegon. He was born April 25, 1937 in Sault Ste. Marie to Joseph and Vivian (Cramer) Cvengros. Ray graduated from Sault Ste. Marie High School and attended Lake Superior State University. On August 24, 1957, he married the love of his life Dora L. "Dorie" Pratt in Muskegon. He worked from 1961-1978 for Breneman-Hartshorn, where he started on a drafting table and worked his way to plant manager. He then worked at American Coil Spring Company as a purchasing manager for 21 years prior to retiring in 1999. He was a dedicated member of First Evangelical Lutheran Church, where he had been active in the SHOP group. Ray had been past President of the National Association of Purchasing Management Club, Greater Muskegon Industrial Management Club, and the Western Michigan Purchasing Association. Ray enjoyed camping with family and friends, boating, fishing, and working in his yard. He loved his grandchildren dearly and was so very proud of them and their accomplishments. 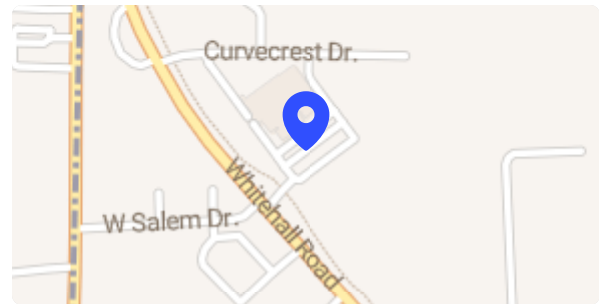

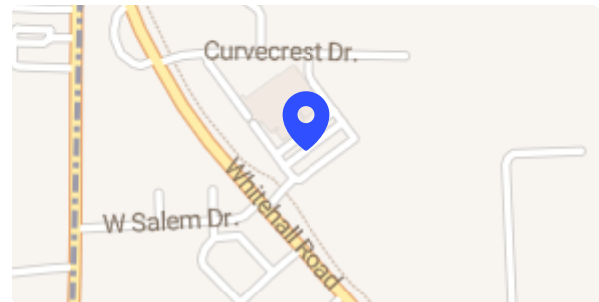
