Mrs. Julie Anne Schugars, 72, passed away August 25, 2020 in Muskegon. She was born April 2, 1948 to Joseph R. and JoAnne (Hollowell) Beyrle in Muskegon, and was a life resident.

Professionally, Julie taught English at Oakridge High School for 36 years, before retiring in 2007. After retiring, she remained active volunteering at Oakridge Elementary school. She was a member of Fellowship Church, very active in Tempting Tables, and participated in Women Who Care. Her six Grandchildren were her passion. She also enjoyed sewing, quilting, reading, and traveling to Hawaii every February after the football season concluded. On August 21, 1971 Julie married Jack R. Schugars and he survives her along with two children, Amanda (Matthew) Lynn, Eric (Carissa) Schugars; grandchildren, Kennedy, Kyah and Janaye Lynn, Hayden, Talan and Teagan Schugars; brothers, Joseph R. (Kathy Alward) Beyrle II, John R. (Jocelyn Greene) Beyrle; numerous nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents, Joseph R. and JoAnne Beyrle. The memorial service will be Monday, August 31, at 11:00 AM at Fellowship Church, 4200 E. Apple Ave., Muskegon, 49442. In addition to the main worship center, the service will be remote streamed in several venues at the church and will also be livestreamed on Fellowship's Facebook and YouTube pages.
