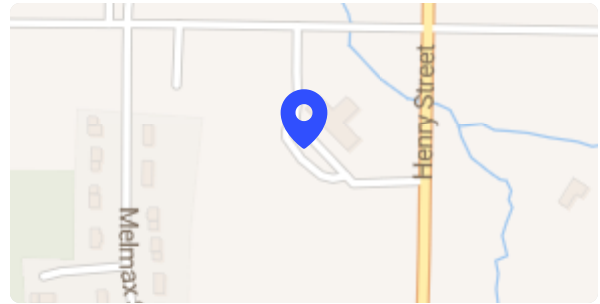
JUN 1, 1964 - APR 8, 2021

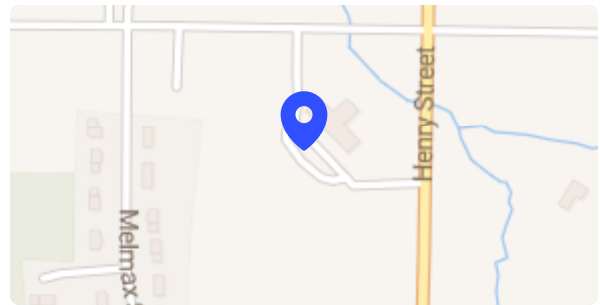
