Linda Rose Pearson, age 79, passed away Wednesday morning, May 12, 2021. She was born November 27, 1941 in Muskegon to Homer and Winifred (Keur) Clark. Linda was a 1960 graduate of Muskegon High School and had worked as a paraprofessional for the Fruitport School district until her retirement. On January 14, 1961, she married Jeffery J. Yates in Muskegon and he preceded her in death on March 5, 1976. She married William C. "Bill" Pearson on September 7, 1976 in Muskegon, who preceded her in death on February 21, 1986. Linda was a faithful member of Port City Church and was a long-time member of the Fruitport Eagles. She was a very social person and enjoyed gathering for breakfast and lunches with family and friends. 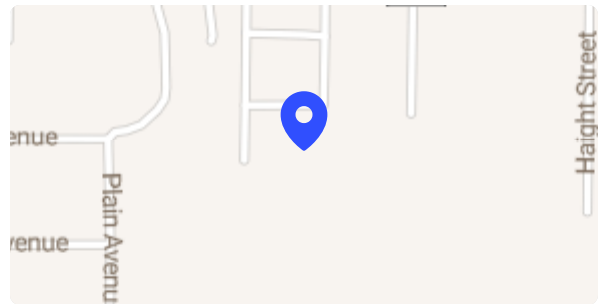

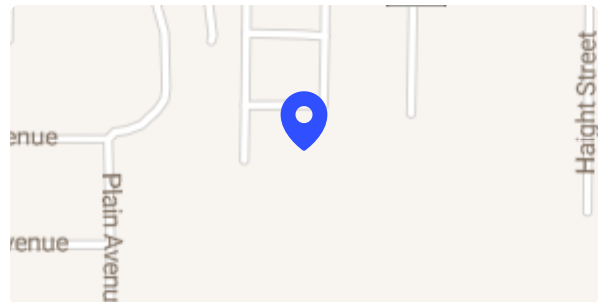

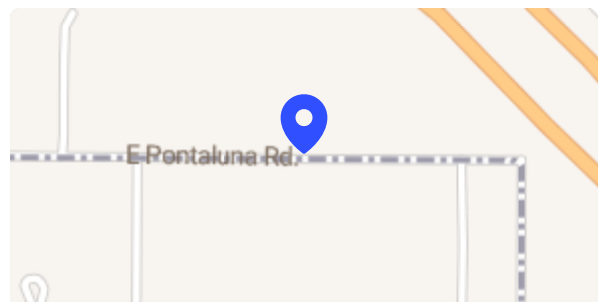
