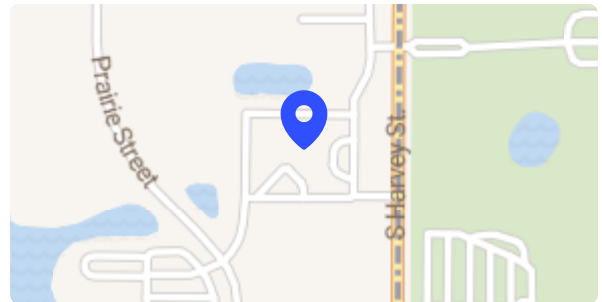

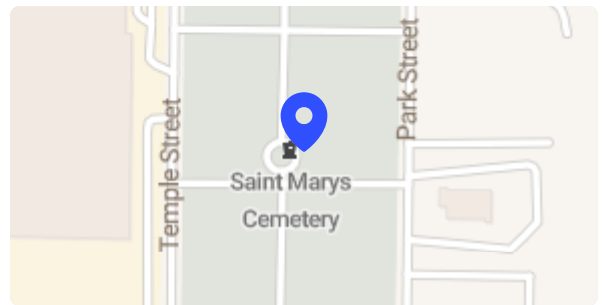

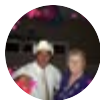


Jeanene Grammar sent a virtual gift in honor of Charles.
