Jean married Wess Robinson and to their union twelve (12) children were born. Wess and Jean moved their family to Muskegon in September of 1972.

Jean accepted Christ at an early age in Earle, AR. She attended Church of Christ formerly located at 1333 Evanston Ave. Jean was a faithful Shepherd of the Lord, where she ministered individuals of all ages. She volunteered many hours in recruiting souls to the Lord by knocking on doors and inviting individuals to church via the Joy Bus.

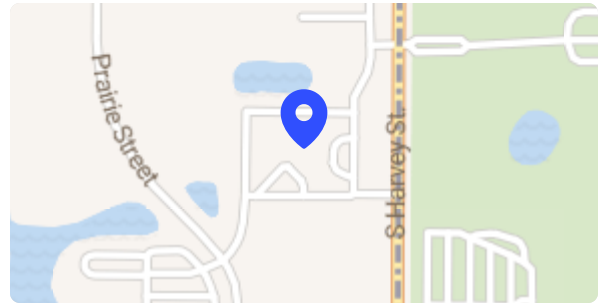

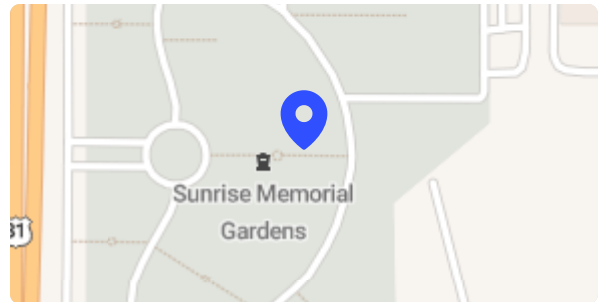
