**R**ichard TenBrink of Grand Haven, passed away Saturday, October 30, 2021. He was born to Simon and Cora (VanWyk) on July 24th 1930, in Zeeland Michigan. He was a veteran of the US Army during the Korean War. Dick drove trucks for Michigan Express for 17 years and owned and operated Dick's Landing for 50 years. Dick loved to fish and spent many years wintering in Florida. He is survived by his four sons: Thomas of Florida, Robert of Allendale, Todd of Allendale, and Dale (Shelley) of Fruitport, six grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. 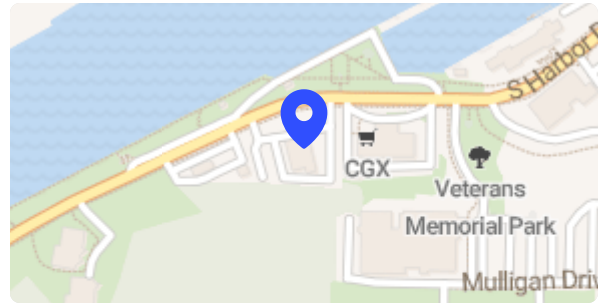

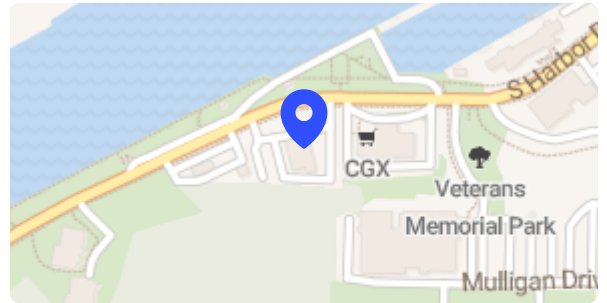
