He was born in the Netherlands on January 22, 1946, to his parents Jacob and Trintje Riesenbeck, and immigrated to the United States in April of 1957. Peter started his own sanitation company, West Michigan Sanitation, which he operated for over 40 years before retiring in 2013. He was a very social person who belonged to many clubs, including the Polish Union and the Lions Club. He at one point was the President of the 7th district of the Fraternal Order of Eagles, and he was currently serving as the treasurer of the Fruitport Eagles #3666 club.
