Lois Marie Chaney, age 96, of Spring Lake passed away Tuesday, January 25, 2022, at North Ottawa Care Center. She was born March 24, 1925, in Union City, Tennessee, to Garrett and Lula Viola (Jackson) Williams and married Harold Curtis Chaney on April 6, 1944, in Hesperia, MI. He preceded her in death in 2016. Lois graduated from Dixie High School in Union City, Tennessee in 1943. She worked at Braaks Bakery for fourteen years, previously worked at Sealed Power in Muskegon, and worked the elections in Spring Lake. 




