Christine graduated from Grand Valley State University Nursing School and had been employed as a nurse at Brookhaven Nursing Home and the Grand Rapids Home for Veterans prior to her retirement. 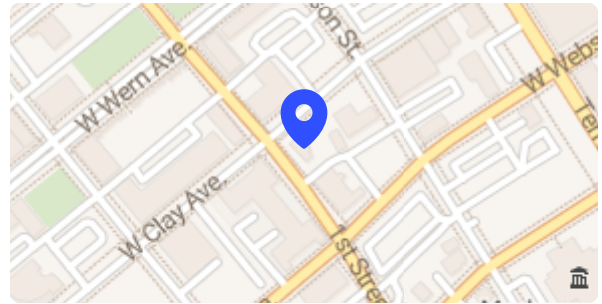

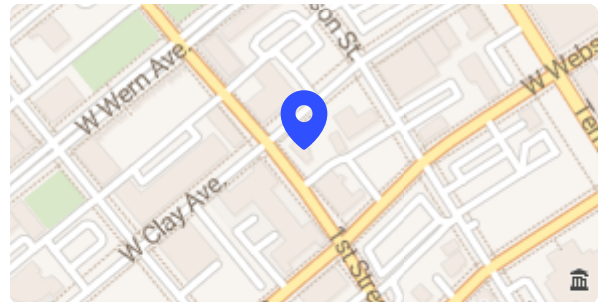

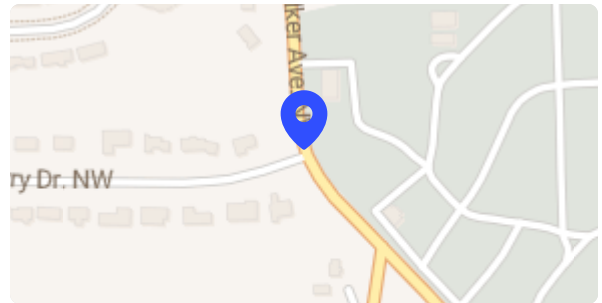
