**D**onald F. Klein, 98, passed away Tuesday afternoon, July 19, 2022. He was born October 14, 1923, to John H. and Mary (Rebman) Klein in Grand Rapids and lived most of his life in the Muskegon area. Don was a member of St. Francis de Sales Catholic Church. He graduated from Muskegon Business School and had been a purchasing agent for Cannon Muskegon before retiring in 1990. Don was a squad leader in WWII mostly in the Philippines. He married Barbara J. Smith on October 21, 1950, and she preceded him in death on June 27, 2000. 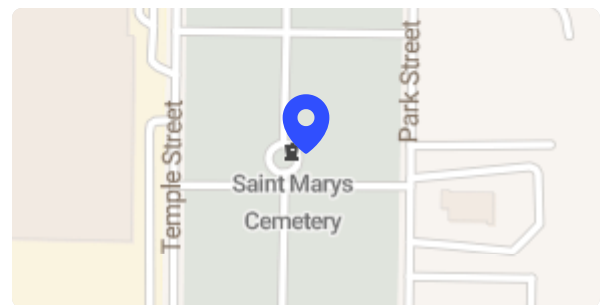
