Mrs. Louise Antonette Neiser, 88, was called home to Our Lord early Wednesday morning, August 10, 2022 after a 3-year courageous battle with cancer. She was born March 29, 1934, in Muskegon to John and Antonette (Kurszewski) Glacz, and was a lifelong resident. She was a member of St. Francis de Sales Catholic Church where she volunteered with the Loaves & Fishes Ministry. Louise enjoyed the outdoors, gardening, puzzles, reading, baking, and most of all spending time with her family. Louise retired from Enterprise Brass Works (EBW), and had previously worked for the City of Muskegon Heights. On June 11, 1955, she married Richard F.
