Paul graduated from Western Michigan University with an education degree. He worked for Ravenna Public Schools for over 31 years both as a teacher and a coach for the girls volleyball, track and quiz bowl teams. Following retirement, Paul taught at Baker College for several years. He loved being outside and was an avid bow hunter and huge fan of the Detroit Red Wings. 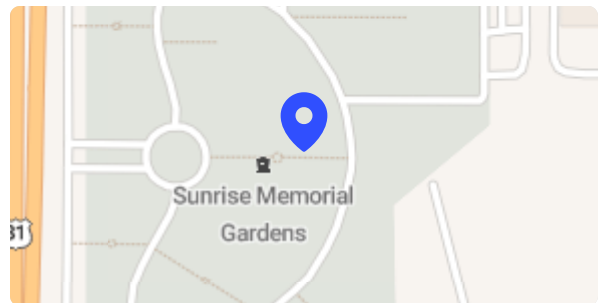
