Mr. Harold Burdell Hines, age 94, passed away November 6, 2012. Harold was born in Muskegon on May 17, 1918 to Fred and Marie (Reynolds) Hines. On June 12, 1951 he married Jerrie Douglas and they enjoyed 57 years together, she preceded him in death in 2009. He worked as a building manager for West Shore Professional Building. Harold was an Army Air Corp pilot during WWII and retired from the Michigan National Guard as Lieutenant Colonel after 30 years of combined service. He was a past chief of the Vikings Lodge Linne No. 57. Harold enjoyed golfing, cribbage and sailing. He is SURVIVED by his children, Jeannie (Ted) Caris, Bill (Buffy) Hines, Tracy Hines; 9 grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren. Harold was PRECEDED in death by his parents; wife, Jerrie; grandson, Christopher R. Caris; brother, Herman Hines; sisters, Florine Loosemore, Maxine Mull. 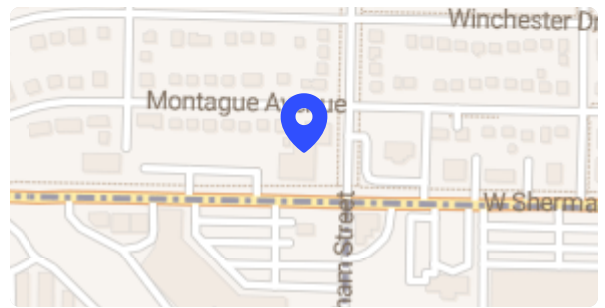

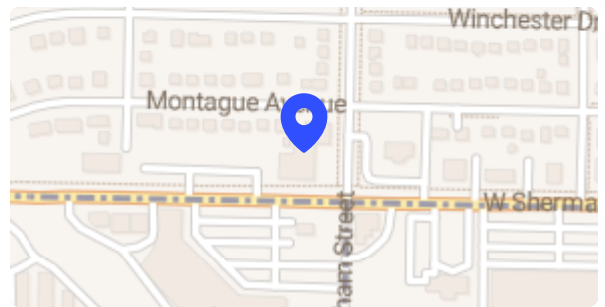

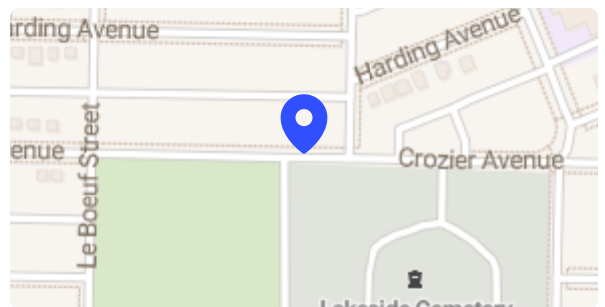
