## **Scott Allen Braspenninx**

**S**cott Alan Braspenninx, age 54, of Springfield, IL, formerly of Ravenna died, Sunday, June 30, 2019, at Memorial Medical Center in Springfield, IL.

Scott was born on April 15, 1965, in Muskegon, MI to the late Gregory and Shirley (Dauchy) Braspenninx. He attended Michigan Technical University where he majored in Chemical Engineering. He applied the knowledge he obtained at Michigan Tech to advance his career in the leather and wastewater industries. Scott was also an outdoor enthusiast, often recalling the numerous summers as a child spent outdoors at his family's cabin on Hamlin Lake.
