Harold F. Wagner, aged 88 of Muskegon, husband of Ilona, died following a brief illness on Friday, April 12, 2013 at the Poppin Hospice Residence. Harold was born on September 16, 1924 in Ravenna to John and Phila (Blanshine) Wagner, and served his country during World War II with the United States Army. On June 24, 1949 he married the love of his life, Ilona Somero, and they have celebrated 63 years together. Harold was a retiree of Teledyne Continental Motors where he worked for 37 years. In his retirement he has enjoyed the outdoors and spending time with his family.
