Leon B. Sheridan age 92, of Ravenna died, Tuesday, March 16, 2010 at his residence surrounded by his family.

Leon was born on November 21, 1917 to the late Terence and Mabel (Blakney) Sheridan. He graduated from Ravenna High School and served in the United States Army during WWII from 1941-45. He married Floretta McNitt on April 23, 1943 in Rolla, Missouri. Leon served on the Ravenna School Board from 1960 to 1968.
