Lois Elaine Knapp, age 78 of Ravenna died Thursday, February 11, 2010 at DeBoer Nursing Home in Muskegon.

Lois was born on July 26, 1931 in Moorland Township, Michigan to the late Joseph G. and Florence (Bentley) Baranowski. She married Charles "Gus" Knapp on April 8, 1949 in Conklin, Michigan and he survives. She was known for making pizzas late at night for the Muskegon County Sheriff's deputies, known as "Lois's Pizzeria".
