## Mr. Edward P. Dailey

FEB 7, 1933 - NOV 17, 2012

**M**r. Edward P. Dailey, age 79, passed away Saturday morning, November 17, 2012. He was born February 7, 1933 in Muskegon to Edward L. and Elaine (Bacon) Dailey. Ed was in the National Guard G Company 126th Infantry for 4 years and was a U.S. Army Veteran of the Korean War. Mr. Dailey worked for Sealed Power for 40 years before retiring in 1995. He was a life member of the VFW Post 3195, was a Golden Eagle at the Muskegon Heights Eagles Aerie #2106, was a member of the Pulaski Lodge, the Old Newsies, the Goodfellows, the Civic Theatre, and a life-time member of the Scottville Clown Band. He was also a member of Fellowship Reformed Church, where he served as a Deacon and Choir member and attended and was involved in DeColores Encristo. Ed enjoyed singing at various churches and groups, and also enjoyed fishing and boating. On May 26, 1956 he married Joyce L. Frizzell in Muskegon and she preceded him in death on July 7, 2010. 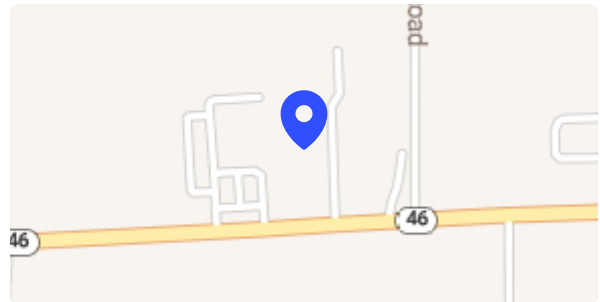

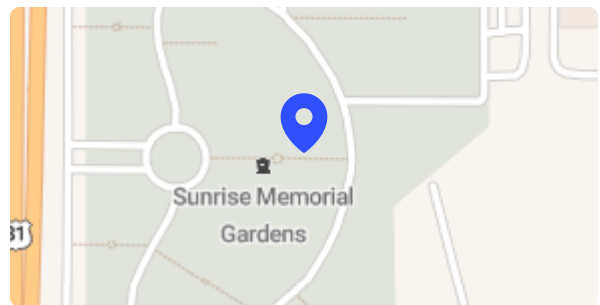
