**A**lice Florence Wildt, age 98, passed away in Muskegon, MI, on Sunday, April 23, 2023. She was born in Le Roy, MI, on December 17, 1924, to Charles and Florence (Miller) Maitland. On December 13, 1947, she married Elwin Wildt, and they spent 55 years together before he preceded her in death in 2003. Alice spent most of her life as a homemaker, but also worked some years as a machinist at Continental Aviation, as a cosmetologist, and producing and selling bean bag furniture with her sister Virginia. Alice enjoyed gardening and fishing, playing cribbage and card games, and spending time with family. She was a hard worker and a great cook. Alice will be lovingly remembered by her two children: Cheryl (Mark) Cribbs and Timothy Wildt; seven grandchildren: Natalie, Sarah, Alicia, Jaime, Andy, Paige, and Sagan; many great-grandchildren; two siblings: Ted and Elaine; and many nieces and nephews. Alice was preceded in death by her parents, Charles and Florence Maitland; husband, Elwin Wildt; and the rest of her siblings. Per her wishes, no public services are being held for Alice.

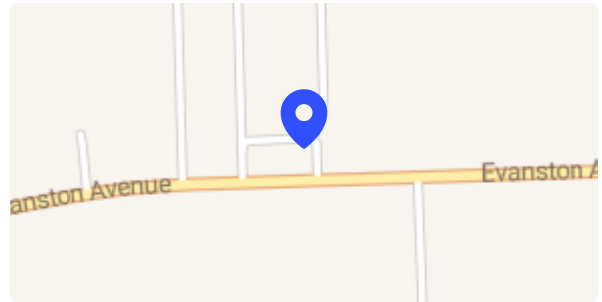
