Arthur “Art” Victor Sierminski, age 92, passed away Tuesday, May 2, 2023. He was born January 4, 1931 to Frank and Mary (Styburski) Sierminski. Art attended Sacred Heart Grammar School and graduated from St. Mary’s High School in 1948. He continued his education at Aquinas College where he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1953 and met the love of his life. 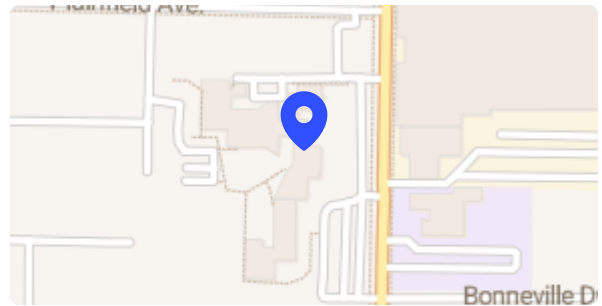

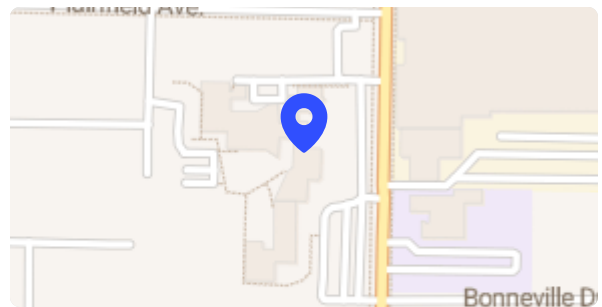

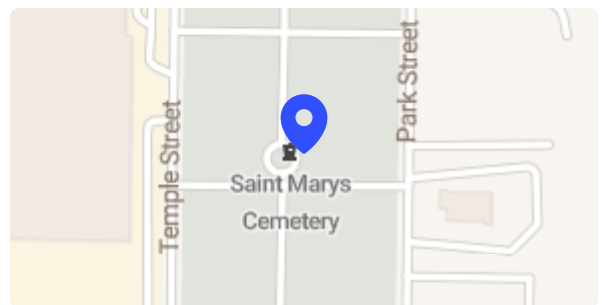
