Mr. William H. "Bill" Bayne, 84, passed away Sunday, May 28, 2023, in Muskegon. He was born January 4, 1939, in Muskegon and lived almost all of his life here. Bill was a U.S. Army veteran and attended Discovering Christ Church (formerly Fifth Reformed). He worked for several years as a truck driver and then served with the Muskegon County Sheriff's Department, retiring after 27 years. Following retirement, he was a bus driver and a quarter horse breeder. On July 7, 1977, Bill married Carolyn A. 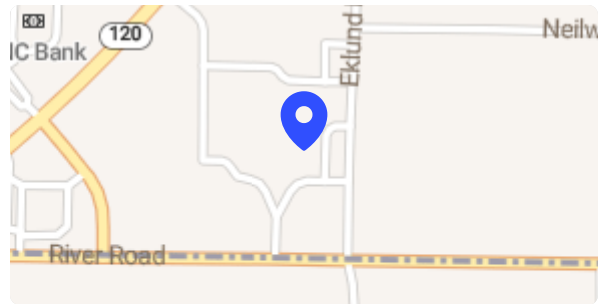

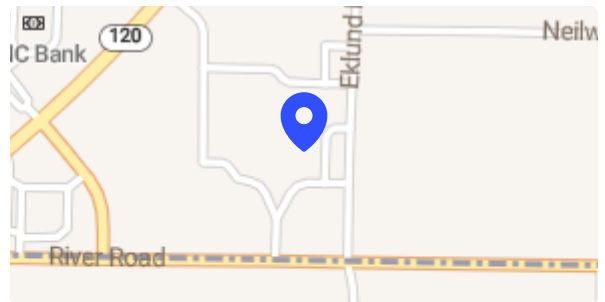
