Mr. Benjamin R. Stroud, 90, passed away Saturday, August 26, 2023, in Muskegon. He was born April 3, 1933, in Grant, MI, and lived most of his life in the Muskegon area. 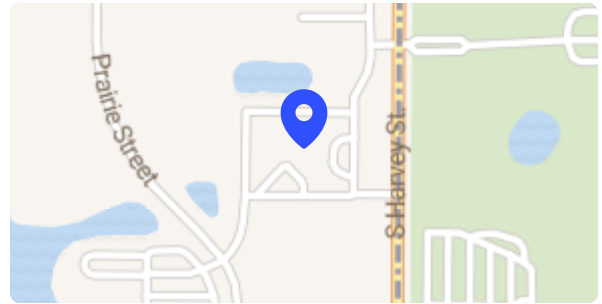

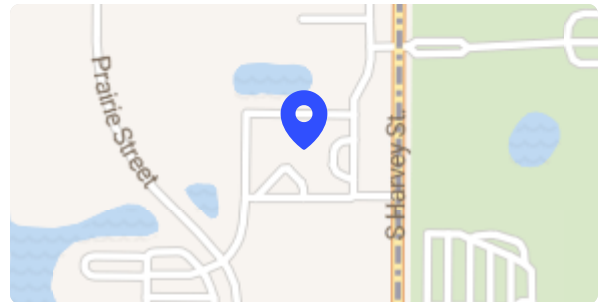

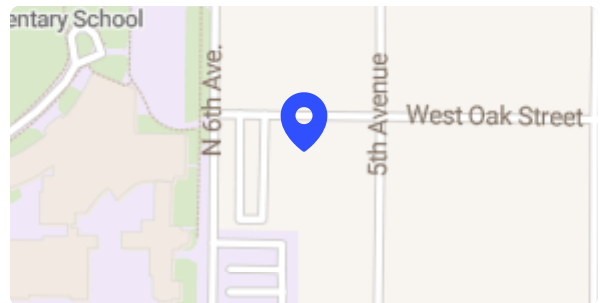
