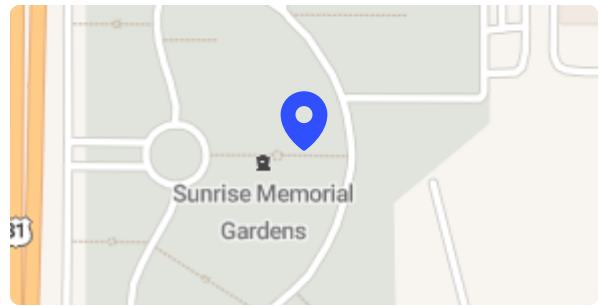
JUL 16, 1936 - JAN 10, 2024
