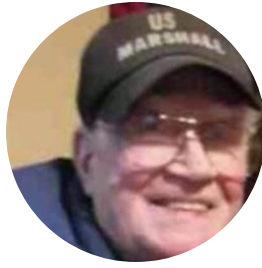

Mr. Robert Charles Marshall, age 82, passed away Friday, January 4, 2013 at Mercy Health Partners. He was born October 23, 1930 in Sparta, MI to Charles and Eleanor (Lang) Marshall and lived in the Muskegon area since 1939. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy having served during the Korean War. On March 1, 1969, he married the former Karen Marie Thompson in Muskegon and she preceded him in death on June 28, 2002. He worked 43 years for Sealed Power Corp. as a standing engineer and retired in 1990. He was a member of Wolf Lake United Methodist Church and was a member of VFW Post #7746. 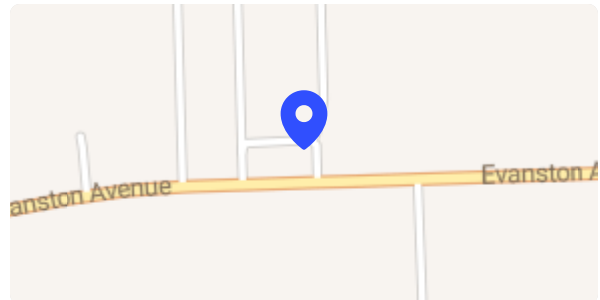
