Alan Edward Johnson, age 58, passed away suddenly on Wednesday, July 3, 2024. Alan was born in Muskegon, MI on August 5, 1965, to Raymond and Bonnie (Rose) Johnson and currently resided in Scottsdale, AZ. He graduated from Mona Shores High School, went on to graduate from Central Michigan University and then worked for 35 years as a Certified Financial Planner.

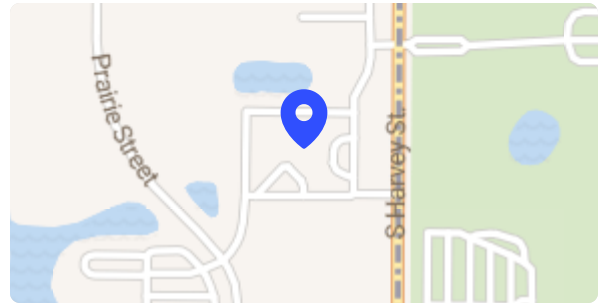

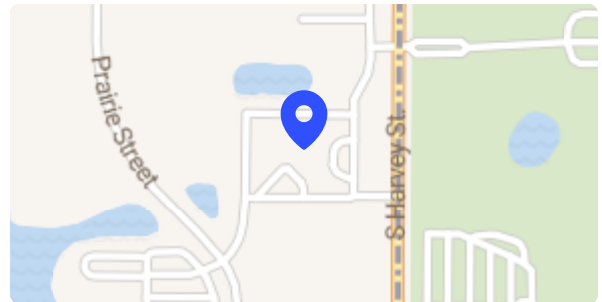

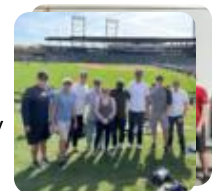
