Mr. Thomas Lyman Peliotes, age 75, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, January 21, 2025 in Muskegon, Michigan with his family by his side. He was born in Muskegon on August 4, 1949 to Frank and Maxine (Wilson) Peliotes. Tom was a veteran of the United States Marines and served in the Vietnam War. He dedicated his entire 55-year career at Durda's D-Auto, never missing a day of work, prior to his retirement this past December.
