# Larry Lee Mock

**L**arry Lee Mock, age 73, passed away Thursday, January 30, 2025. He was born June 2, 1951, in Grand Haven, MI to Lester and Betty (Hudson) Mock and had resided in Florida and Kentucky for many years until moving back to Muskegon.

Larry was a proud U.S. Marine Corp Veteran and served his country as a sniper during Vietnam, receiving three Purple Hearts during his service. He worked his entire life as a logger and roofer until his health forced his retirement. On November 2, 1996, he married Patricia Ann "Patti" Schumacher in Nelsonville, OH and she survives him.

While living in Silver Springs, Florida, he was a member of the Fraternal Order of the Eagles and the Moose Lodge. Larry enjoyed hunting and fishing and loved riding his Harley Davidson motorcycles and at one time belonged to the Viet Nam Vets Motorcycle Club. He was very sociable and loved to party with friends and family.

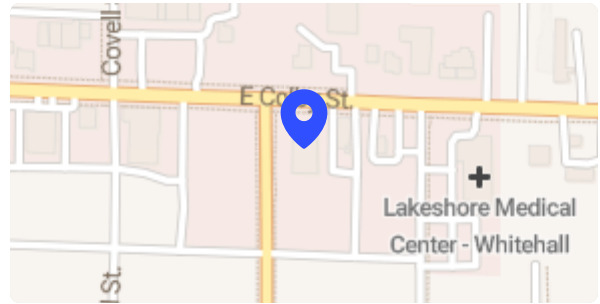

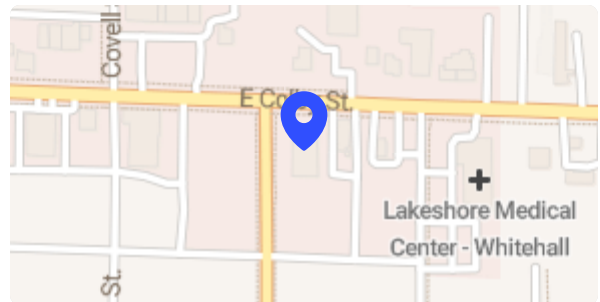
