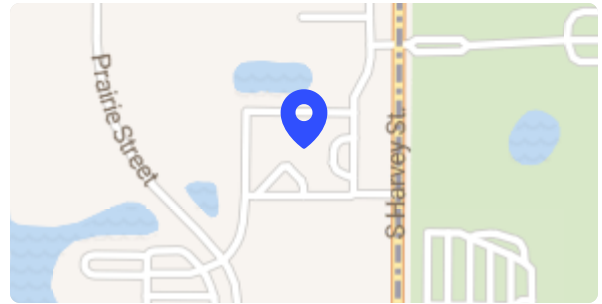

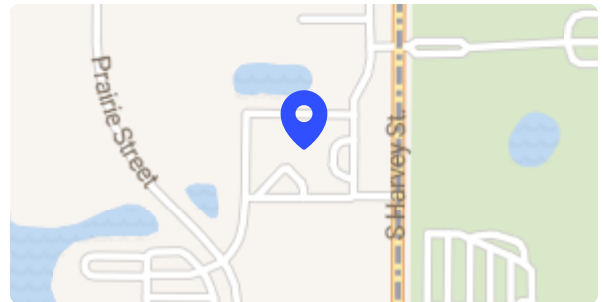

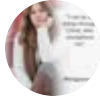

When I was 12 or 13 we used to go vicky house running in an out eating all her snacks an sneekong pops or beers..

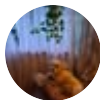
