## Mr. Ronald "Ron" McFall

AUG 9, 1936 - FEB 12, 2013

**M**r. Ronald "Ron" McFall, age 76, passed away Tuesday, February 12, 2013 at the Poppen Residence. He was born August 9, 1936 in Muskegon to Brice and Helen (Knerr) McFall and lived all of his life in the area. Ron was a veteran of the U.S. Navy. On July 6, 1960, he married the former Phyllis M. Hansen in Muskegon. Ron worked nearly 20 years for Terminix, Inc. as an exterminator. Ron and Phyllis were the owners and operators of McFall's Gas and Grocery for 15 years and later were the owners and operators of Hobbies-4-You until Ron's retirement in 2000. Ron had a special hobby of metal detecting and was an avid fisherman. He also was an antique car collector and was very proud of his 1927 Model T that was in nearly perfect original condition. 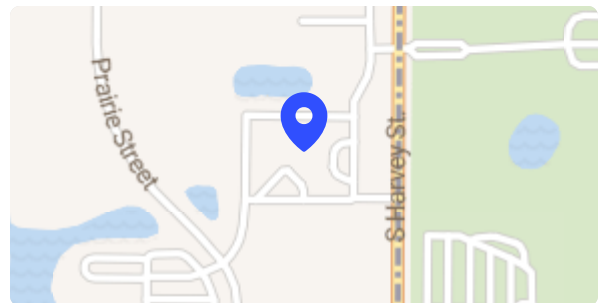

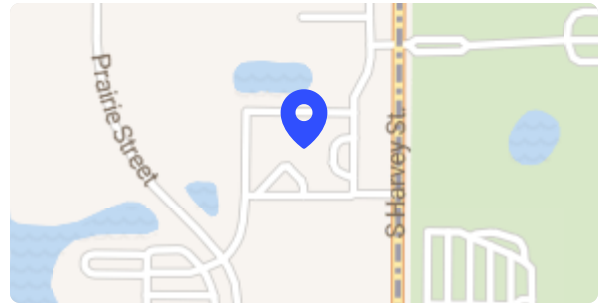
