## **Mrs. Veronica B. Spaniola**

**M**rs. Veronica B. (Cordo) Spaniola, age 92, passed away Sunday, March 17, 2013 at her home. She was born October 20, 1920 in Muskegon to Rosario and Catherine (Cantafi) Cordo and lived her entire life in the area. On November 4, 1950, she married William P. Spaniola in Muskegon and he preceded her in death on November 21, 2003. Veronica worked for a time as a supervisor at Teledyne-Continental Motors before spending the remainder of her career raising her family. She was a lifetime member of Our Lady of Grace Catholic Church where she was active with the Ladies Guild.
